Dear Reader,

The shortest and the least expensive route to become a graduate engineer is AMIE. Below we furnish the details of AMIE re-registration and postal coaching.

Who Can Apply for Re-registration?

There are two kinds of re-registration.

1. Mature re-registration **And**
2. Pre-mature re-registration.

As we know the validity of registration (either Section A/B) is six years or 12 examination chances. If a student does not clear all subjects in Section A (or B) in six year's time, his AMIE registration automatically expires and he loses the credit of any subjects already passed. But this does not mean that he cannot attempt AMIE again. He can re-register for AMIE and will get another six years for clearing Section A (or B). The re-registration made *after six years* is hence called mature re-registration.

Meanwhile, students whose registration validity is *nearing expiry* can also apply for re-registration. This is called pre-mature re-registration. This facility is not available for Section A Diploma stream candidates.

The applicability of pre-mature re-registration is calculated on the basis of number of remaining examination chances and number of subjects that need to be cleared for completely passing either Section A or Section B. As a general rule, if the remaining examination chances are sufficient for clearing all balance subjects in section A/B, the student cannot apply for pre-mature re-registration.

SYLLABUS

Those who re-register now has to write examination in the existing syllabus only.

A diploma holder need to study only 4 subjects in Section A, while a non-diploma (+2 holder) studies 10 subjects in Section A.

Following are the **subjects in Section A (As per current syllabus w.e.f Summer 2005)**

The detailed subject-wise syllabus shall be given to you along with our post course materials.

In section B, student is asked to select a branch of engineering. Following are the engineering branches available.

1. Electronics and communication Engineering
2. Electrical Engineering
3. Computer Science and Engineering
4. Civil Engineering
5. Mechanical Engineering
6. Production Engineering
7. Chemical Engineering
8. Materials and Metallurgical Engineering
9. Mining Engineering
10. Textile Engineering
11. Architectural Engineering.

Both Diploma and Non-diploma holders should study **9 subjects in Section B**. Of this 9 subjects, 6 are compulsory and 3 are optional. In order to impart practical knowledge, the Institution of Engineers has included project work and lab experiments as part of section B syllabus.

In short, a +2 holder can complete AMIE by clearing just $10 + 9 = 19$ subjects, whereas for a diploma holder, the total subject is $4 + 9 = 13$ only.

The project work may be done in the same firm/company where the student is presently engaged in. For doing laboratory experiment, the Institution of Engineers will contact the authorities of some engineering college/similar technical institution nearest to the location of the student and make necessary arrangement.

DURATION

6 years are available for clearing all Section A subjects and another 6 years for completing Section B.

However, with systematic study one can complete the course in minimum time. This is how it works:- In one semester a student can appear for maximum 4 subjects. If a student appears and clears maximum number of subjects in each attempt then he can clear AMIE in minimum time.

How to Study

The AMIE syllabus is freely downloadable from website. The IEI doesn't take any responsibility for teaching you. The IEI will conduct examination and will issue certificates and that's all. Students must find their own way to study the subject to prepare well for examination. Since AMIE is a degree level examination, a peripheral knowledge on the subject will not be sufficient for scoring pass mark in the exam.

Students seeking Section A re-registration can join by paying the first installment mentioned above (Rs 7700/-) which includes fee for first Semester course materials + Fee for re-registration + Processing charges. The balance fee is payable in installments (semester-wise).

Apart from the fee mentioned above students will have to pay exam fee (Rs 3000/- per semester), Section B Registration fee (Rs 4800/-), and Laboratory fee (Rs 7000/-).

When to Join?

“Now itself”, is the answer. If your registration is expired/ expiring, you can apply at any time. It is important that, after submitting the joining form you have to wait for some time before appearing for your first examination. This is due to the time taken for processing your application form. Hence submitting your application at the earliest will save time.

PREMATURE RE-REGISTRATION

Instructions:

Eligibility : Candidates be permitted to apply for premature registration, after the expiry of five years of stipulated six years period when they have not sufficient time to pass the balance subjects of Section A/Section B examination. Such candidates may submit their premature re-registration form for another six years period to appear afresh in all subjects of Section A/ Section B with the following condition(s).

Condition :

For Section A (Non-diploma)

Candidates passed only one subject in Section A (Non-diploma) till the expiry of five years of stipulated six years period, are eligible to apply for premature re-registration. **[Candidates passed two or more subjects in Section A (Non-diploma) after the expiry of five years of stipulated six years period are not eligible to apply for premature re-registration.]**

For Section A (Diploma)

Candidates in Section A (Diploma) are not eligible to apply for premature re-registration.

For Section B

Candidates, who are unable to pass any subject in Section B till the expiry of five years of stipulated six years period, are eligible to apply for premature re-registration. **[Candidates passing one or more subject(s) in Section B after the expiry of five years of stipulated six years period are not eligible to apply for premature re-registration.]**

- **Six year period shall be counted from Summer examination of the year in which a candidate submits his/her application for this purpose.**
- **For Section A candidates, subject exemption, if any, shall be forfeited after premature re-registration.**
- **For Section B candidates, pass status of Section A examination will remain unaltered.**
